



LOOKING FOR MALE Volunteers at Warwickshire Children's Charity

HELP MAKE A DIFFERENCE TO A YOUNG BOY'S LIFE

The Friendship Project for Children is looking for male volunteers to be friend boys between the ages of 6-16 in need of some extra support. The volunteers need to have access to a car and be able to take the boys out and provide some undivided attention once a week, for 2-3 hours.

All volunteers have Safeguarding and Child Protection training and their own Area Co-ordinator to support and advise them. Volunteers are matched with a boy that has similar interests to them, and the emphasis is to have fun, with the knock-on effect/consequence that their young person's self confidence and self-esteem improves. The Safeguarding and support of our volunteers and our young people are paramount to the charity.

"We are fortunate to have many female volunteers apply to volunteer with us – and we match them with both girls and boys. However, we always have more referrals from social services for boys but not enough male volunteers to support them. It would be great to have more male volunteers to match with our boys. The activities that could be enjoyed during the friendships are endless - a walk in the park, kicking a ball around, painting, baking, cinema trips, bike rides, climbing walls and all generally involve food, but the 'Older' and 'Younger Friends' can decide together what works for them ". Heather Shipley, Area Co-ordinator, Stratford district.

Applicants will go through our strict interview process and provide two character references. Volunteers are required to apply for an Enhanced DBS certificate (criminal records check), which is paid for by the Charity. Induction and Safeguarding training are given to all volunteers on an on-going basis.

An existing male volunteer at the Friendship Project reports "I have wanted to do something like working with the Friendship project for years,

but have always put it off, or to be honest, been too worried to volunteer for Safeguarding reasons. Over the last year, I have looked at what makes me happy and helping others makes me happy; so I applied and thought I would see what happened. It is truly a fantastic idea for both the volunteer and child. The charity is run very well, with quality, prompt support when needed. The idea of taking someone else's child out for a few hours seems strange to most and I didn't really see how only spending a few hours each week could be of benefit. My younger friend tells me, he now has a best friend and that he has never really felt like he had one before. I can now see the difference I am making".

WINTER FUEL PAYMENT

HOW MUCH COULD I GET?

If you were born on or before 26 September 1955 you could get between £100 and £300 to help with your bills in the winter of 2021-2022. However, you'll usually get less if you live with other people who also qualify or if you live in a care home or nursing home and don't get one of the following benefits:

- Pension Credit
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Income Support

If you live in a care home or nursing home and receive any of these benefits then you're not entitled to a Winter Fuel Payment.

AM I ELIGIBLE TO CLAIM WINTER FUEL PAYMENT?

You may be eligible for Winter Fuel Payment for winter 2021-2022 if you meet all the following criteria:

- you were born on or before 26 September 1955 (the eligibility birth date changes every financial year).
- you lived in the UK throughout the qualifying week for the financial year of 2021–2022, which is 20–26 September 2021).

HOW CAN I CLAIM WINTER FUEL PAYMENT?

However, as well as the eligibility criteria above, you'll also need to:

- receive the State Pension
- receive another social security benefit (this doesn't include Housing Benefit, Council Tax Reduction, Child Benefit or Universal Credit, or a deferred State Pension).

If you're eligible and receive the necessary benefits, you will receive your Winter Fuel Payment automatically and won't have to make a claim. If you're eligible but don't receive these benefits or live abroad, you may need to make a claim.

To make a claim, you can call the Winter Fuel Payment helpline on 0800 731 0160. You'll need your National Insurance number and your bank or building society details when making a claim.

COLD WEATHER PAYMENT

HOW MUCH IS A COLD WEATHER PAYMENT?

You get £25 a week for each 7 day period of cold weather. This only applies between 1 November and 31 March each year.

Cold weather is defined by the Met Office as being when the average temperature has been, or is expected to be, 0°C or below for 7 days in a row. The Met Office use specific weather stations that forecast and record temperatures.

AM LELIGIBLE FOR THE COLD WEATHER PAYMENT?

The average temperature in your area needs to have been 0°C or less for seven consecutive days. You can check your area's temperature by using the DWP's cold weather payment postcode checker (www. coldweatherpayments.dwp.gov.uk). You also need to be receiving certain benefits, such as Pension Credit or certain other benefits.

HOW CAN I CLAIM A COLD WEATHER PAYMENT?

If you're eligible for a Cold Weather Payment, you'll be paid automatically after each 7 day period of cold weather. You should receive your payment within 14 working days.

Contact your pension centre or Jobcentre Plus office if you think you should have received a Cold Weather Payment but didn't. If you receive Universal Credit, contact the Universal Credit helpline on 0800 328 9344.

RIGHT TO REPAIR

YOUR APPLIANCES

Our modern lifestyles and homes could not be imagined without gadgets, on demand entertainment, education and convenience. We can no longer imagine running a household without an army of appliances helping us to clean, wash, dry and cook, etc. Electronics purchased not so many years back were often repaired and maintained for decades, compared to a few short years on many of the latest designed products. So, what's happened and why do we create so much waste by getting rid of relatively new electronics because it is cheaper to buy a new one than to repair it?

In recent years the window to repair has become smaller and smaller for some questionable reasons, which quite often aligns with market saturation. Inflated cost and restricted access to spare parts, software and hardware pairing, deliberate under-engineering, unique screw types or parts glued together to make a repair more awkward or simply no longer viable. There are many claimed reasons for this, which include the reduction of cost and safety of the customer. Although this may be true to a point, this is often combined with only allowing selected professionals having access to manuals and parts. It appears that this would be an ideal method of business to increase new product sales, if you were to self-regulate, even if indirect.

Recently introduced legislation aims to provide consumers with a 'Right to Repair' within the UK and aims to have manufacturers make repair information and spare parts available for repairs for up to 10 years for some new white goods and

televisions.
Although this may be good for now, it omits most small electronics and falls short of making sure spare parts are made widely available at a fair price.

A spare part with an inflated price will often remove the viability of the repair and even more so when combined with controlled narrow repair options. While this may be a good step in the right direction with the rules already starting to evolve, it has been this way for some time and will take more time to be truly addressed, if ever, Although this will hopefully improve the lifespan of many products it will apply to, there are still many questions regarding the product end-of-life material recovery. The UK has a very high level of electrical waste, which can only improve if the ability to break down the product is made simple. The materials used also need to be worth recovering/recyclable and this should be considered in initial design processes.

If we are serious about stepping away from a throwaway economy model, we should push harder to improve access to spare parts and repair information for all products to everyone and incentivise repairs. This would be a more universal right to repair, so that all

products can be repaired, reused and kept out of landfill, incineration and recycling centres for as long as possible.
