QUEENS PLATINUM JUBILEE: IN CELEBRATION OF A REMARKABLE LADY

On 6th February 2022, Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II became the first British Monarch to celebrate a Platinum Jubilee, marking 70 years since her accession to the throne. This astonishing achievement makes her the longest reigning living monarch anywhere in the world. According to the Guinness Book of Records, the title was previously held by King Bhumibol Adulyadej of Thailand until his death in 2016. His rule of 70 years 126 days was the second longest reign of a sovereign state in history. The longest-reigning monarch ever was King Louis XIV, who presided over France for 72 years 110 days (14 May 1643 - 1 September 1715).

There is a year-long schedule of events to mark the occasion, and we're all being encouraged to play our part even in a small way. For example there's The Queen's Green Canopy project where communities are being helped to "plant a tree for the Jubilee" (www.queensgreencanopy.org). Plus we can buy souvenirs through the official Royal Collection shop

(www.royalcollectionshop.co.uk).

But all eyes will be on the first weekend of June when the Platinum Jubilee celebrations begin in earnest, with the main events set to take place between Thursday 2nd and Sunday 5th June. We have an additional one-off bank holiday in England on 3rd June with the Spring Bank Holiday (which usually falls in late May) having been moved to 2nd June, creating a four-day weekend.

HERE'S THE ORDER OF EVENTS FOR THE PLATINUM JUBILEE WEEKEND:

THURSDAY 2ND JUNE - TROOPING THE COLOUR from Buckingham Palace to Horse Guards Parade, ending with an RAF fly-past, watched by the Queen from the balcony of Buckingham Palace. Members of the public can apply for tickets via the website bp.army.mod.uk/ queensbirthdayparade/ Thursday will also see 1,500 beacons being lit throughout the United Kingdom, Channel Islands, Isle of Man and UK Overseas Territories, plus (for



the first time) in each of the capital cities of the Commonwealth countries.

FRIDAY 3RD JUNE - SERVICE OF THANKSGIVING at St Paul's Cathedral.

SATURDAY 4TH JUNE - PLATINUM PARTY AT THE

PALACE, a special live concert from Buckingham Palace that will bring together some of the world's biggest entertainment stars. Members of the public will be invited to apply for tickets, for more information go to www.royal.uk/platinumjubileecentral-weekend.

SUNDAY 5TH JUNE - THE BIG JUBILEE LUNCH where local communities are encouraged to come together, celebrate their connections and get to know each other a little bit better. Meanwhile in London the Platinum Jubilee Pageant will involve performers, dancers, musicians, military personnel, key workers and volunteers. Part of this event includes the River of Hope, which will comprise of two hundred silk flags which will process down The Mall, appearing like a moving river. Primary and secondary school children are invited to create a picture of their hopes and aspirations for the planet over the next 70 years. You can register your school's interest to take part via riverofhope.co.uk. If you're planning your own local celebrations to mark this momentous event, then the Royal Family has created a wealth of free resources to help via www.roval.uk/resourcesplatinumjubilee

The Birmingham 2022 Festival has announced its six-month-long cultural programme taking place across the West Midlands. It will be the biggest celebration of creativity ever seen in the region and one of the largest ever cultural programmes to surround the Commonwealth Games. Events will be running from March to September and the festival will put Birmingham and the West Midlands' creativity, ambition, heritage and diversity on a global stage. Some of the highlights include:

On Record – A brand-new album featuring eleven original songs about Birmingham offers a sonic love letter to the city. Featuring new songs by Birmingham artists - including SANITY, UB40 and Dapz on the Map - On Record has been created and produced by Jez Collins of Birmingham Music Archive and Grammy-nominated producer Simon Duggal. The multi-genre work will be available via a limited vinyl release and across all streaming platforms from Saturday 18 June. A new podcast and live event programme, In Conversation, will complement the album.

Time Travel Tram - Passengers on board a West Midlands Metro tram between Wolverhampton and Birmingham will be taken back in time while experiencing the world's first immersive digital art powered by 5G. Time Travel Tram, created by immersive storytellers Surfing Light Beams and Crossover Labs, launches living history into the 21st century by transforming the view from the tram windows into a 3Dvisual extravaganza of people and places from the region's past. Running throughout the duration of the festival, from 21 March – 30 September, Time Travel Tram will be accompanied by a contemporary

People, Place and Sport – Artist Jaskirt Boora explores the role of gender and ethnicity in sport through a series of photographic portraits and recorded conversations. People, Place and Sport - a collaboration with West Bromwich based community arts organisation Multistory - is a celebration of local communities and grassroots sport in the West Midlands and will take place from April to August in leisure centres across the region, as well as outdoors at Sandwell Valley Country Park.

Warwickshire will be playing host Talking Birds' Come Bowl With Me, which is a funny and interactive outdoor performance by acclaimed Coventry theatre company Talking Birds, celebrating the popular and accessible sport of Lawn Bowls.

Audiences are invited to join Lorna Bowles, Dwaine Hardball and Roger Rinkwell as they coach you through the gentle joys and fierce competition of this much-loved game. Tensions may rise in the Strictly Come Bowling arena as players compete for the Glitter Bowl Trophy. After a round of Crazy Bowls, the crowd will be amazed by the antics of Cirque du Boules and their terrifying Great Bowls of Fire.

Come Bowl with Me will be in Learnington Spa's Pump Room Gardens from 16 to 17 July 2022. HOW TO SAVE ON ENERGY COSTS IN 2022

It cannot have escaped your attention that our energy bills are set to rise by over 50% this year. A worldwide squeeze on energy supplies has pushed the price of gas up to unprecedented levels. The UK is particularly hard-hit because about 85% of our homes have gas central heating, and gas generates a third of the country's electricity.

In the past, we have always been encouraged to shop around when energy bills rise, but that option is no longer available due to the collapse of so many of the smaller, more competitively priced energy companies. This means we're having to look for more creative ways to save on our fuel bills, for example by making improvements to the energy efficiency of our homes. Even the smallest of changes – when done consistently - could help offset rising prices and keep your energy bills at more manageable levels.

Here are our top six tips for saving energy at home, courtesy of the Energy Saving Trust. Adopt them all and you could save around £200 to £300 per year on your fuel bills!

I. TURN OFF STANDBY APPLIANCES AT THE PLUG

estimated average saving of £30 a year. Use plug sockets that can be turned on and off via our phone, to make sure you switch unused appliances off. Or you could use cheaper timer plugs to schedule turning appliances on and off.

2. INSTALL A SMART THERMOSTAT estimated average saving of £75 a year. Smart thermostats can make your heating more efficient by only warming the rooms you are using. They work by learning how long it takes to heat your home, so they can have it at the right temperature at exactly the right time. They can also be controlled by your phone, which means you won't have to come back to a cold home.



3. TURN DOWN YOUR THERMOSTAT estimated average saving of £80 per year by turning your heating down by just one degree. 4. BUY ENERGY EFFICIENT APPLIANCES estimated average saving of between £7 to £65 a year. If you need to renew an appliance, choose one with a high energy-efficiency rating. An A+++ washing machine will typically use £65 less energy than an A+ one over an 11-year product lifespan. A modern, efficient dishwasher will typically cost around £7 less a year to run compared to an older model.

5. WASH CLOTHES AT A LOWER TEMPERATURE

estimated average saving of £5 a year just by washing at 30 degrees rather than 40 degrees. (Bonus tip: most household detergent brands produce a perfectly good wash at 30 degrees.)

6. INVEST IN SOME DRAFT PROOFING estimated average saving £35 a year. Use draught excluders or draught-proofing kits to seal cracks in skirting boards and floors. If you don't have double glazing then you can buy special plastic lining for your windows.
