

England's flying insect population has declined by 65% in the last 20 years. Their rate of loss is 8x faster than bird and animal loss. Without any doubt, we need our insect population... to sustain life for us all on this planet.

Why is this happening? Loss of habitat due to building and farming practices, changing temperatures, pesticide use, to name but a few of the challenges the insects face. After reviewing over 150 scientific studies, scientists concluded that there is yet another important but overlooked factor in the insect population apocalypse. Light, when it should be dark.

Two thirds of invertebrates are partially or wholly most active at night. We usually do not notice them. But, whilst we are tucked up in bed or glued to one of our many screens, these insects are busy working on essential tasks, pollinating our crops, flowers and fruits, recycling nutrients, controlling pests, and of course they themselves act as food for other creatures...all part of the eco system to which we belong! These insects we rarely see, are as vital to our future survival as the daytime insects we all recognise, they are the unseen night shift heroes of the planet!

Since life began to evolve, plants and creatures, including humans, have responded to light and dark appearing at habitual times in a 24-hour period. However, artificial light at night disrupts these "circadian rhythms".

Many insects are attracted to light. Scientists believe that insects are drawn to light instinctively because they use it as a guide, relying on the sun, moon and stars to find their way about. These are their signposts. Artificial light confuses them, they can often be seen circling around a light at night. By morning, at least a third of these insects will be dead, through utter exhaustion, overheating, dehydration, or loss of navigation skills so they cannot find their way home.

Buglife say that light pollution has been shown to reduce nocturnal pollinator visits to flowers by around 62% in some areas, caterpillar populations have been found to be in decline by around 52% near to street lighting, dung beetles are found to become disorientated, insect reproduction and hatching cycles may be affected.

"The evidence that light pollution has profound and serious impacts on our ecosystem is overwhelmingly strong. It is imperative that substantial steps are taken to make the environment safer for insects." (Matt Shardlow, BUGLIFE)

We can play our part!

Only use outside lights that are essential. Draw the blinds. Try to use motion sensor solar lights, so the light is only on for a short time. Direct lights away from wild areas.

Place lights as low as possible and point them downwards.

Choose low intensity, dim lighting, warmer hues, warm white, yellow or amber. These are somewhat less likely to affect wildlife. Ask your council to consider switching off lights at a time after midnight, this has been found to help insect life.

Let's "nurture the night shift", every light turned down or off helps!
