



Mow little and often to control the height.

March and April are the busiest months of the year for growing grass seed and an ideal time to overseed your lawn or sow a new lawn from scratch!

Some grass seeds can grow in cold weather down to 5 degrees whilst others need 10-12 degrees Celsius to germinate so it's important to check the weather and pick the right grass seed for your lawn.

By following these easy tips and hints you will lay a good foundation in March for a luxurious lawn that will look fantastic all year.



February can be a busy time in the vegetable garden with jobs including sowing seeds, cropping winter veg, garden organization, and projects to plan.

The days might still be short, frosts heavy and snow lying on the ground, but February is a busy month in the vegetable garden and gardeners can get a head start on a busy spring. Here are some jobs to do in February.

SEEDS TO SOW IN FEBRUARY

Some seeds have a long germination time, and you can sow many seeds both undercover and outdoors.

 $\ensuremath{\texttt{OUTSIDE}}$ SOWING if the ground isn't frozen, now is the time to plant shallot sets, broad beans, and garlic directly in the soil.

(OLD SOW INDOORS seeds that you can sow now undercover include winter salad leaves, sprouting broccoli, leeks, spinach, kohlrabi, peas, and onions. Undercover can mean in an unheated greenhouse, but also on a bright windowsill in the house.

HEAT LOVING SEEDS TO SOW IN FEBRUARY propagators and grow lights can help get your seeds started early by providing extra warmth and light when both are in short supply. Seeds you can sow in February undercover with heat include tomatoes, peppers, aubergine, globe artichokes, and chillis.

ORDER AND CHIT POTATOES

February is a great time to order and chit seed potatoes. There are hundreds of potato varieties, but the ones we tend to grow fall into categories of cooking type and how long they take to harvest. First earlies generally take around 55-70 days from planting to harvest and should be chitted first.

ORGANIZE SEEDS AND SEED PACKETS

February is a perfect time to organize your seeds. Why not look through your stock and check the use-by dates, then buy new ones. Most seeds will have a good percentage that will germinate after being kept for some time, but generally the longer the time that has elapsed, the fewer seeds will sprout.

GENERAL FEBRUARY GARDEN JOBS

February is a great time to start with a clean slate. Why not reorganize and deep clean the greenhouse, pots, cloches, and labels. Check your tool kit and repair, service, and replace broken tools. Why not sit down and draw up your garden plan for this year. It will help you use your space more efficiently and decide what you want to grow where.

FEBRUARY GARDEN JOBS (HECKLIST Organize seeds and place orders.

Seeds to sow in February: tomatoes, aubergine, chillis, kale, winter salad leaves, peas, sprouting broccoli, leeks, spinach, kohlrabi and globe artichokes.

- Plant shallots and garlic.
- Order and chit potatoes.
- Plant bare-root fruit trees and bushes.
- Prune fruit trees and bushes.
- Mulch perennial vegetables.
- Harvest brussels sprouts, parsnips, cabbages, cauliflower, kale, and leeks.
- Build raised beds, install a greenhouse, create garden paths, weave raspberry cane edging, build a raspberry trellis.
- Remove weeds, create a seedbed, turn the compost heap.
